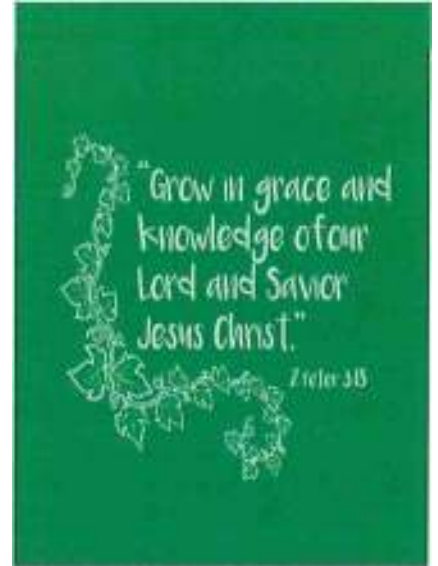

11. Science - On Tuesday the science classes harvested their lettuce crop which was planted Aug. 31 in the aquaponic setup. Students washed their hands and the lettuce. They added cheese and a cracker to make a snack. All reports were that it tasted very good, and we talked about the food value of each part. All the lettuce is gone, the grow bed is bare, and the class talked about what they would plant next. The overall idea is to raise a nourishing food in a short time like is being done on Timor. The "control plants" which were grown in a window sill were very much smaller.
