We will be raking leaves this Wednesday, so please have your child dress appropriately for the weather and working outside.

Christ Light: Our new stories for this week are "The Second Journey of Joseph's Brothers" and "Joseph Makes Himself Known".

Reading: We will finally finish reading our "Beezus and Ramona" book this week! We will also pick out a story or poem to start learning for our Forensics night, Nov. 9th.
