3rd and 4th Grade Weekly News

Notes from Mrs. Biedenbender: The 3rd & 4th graders sang some Christmas hymns for the Trinity Ladies' Guild Christmas party last Thursday. They did a great job and were excited to use their musical gifts to glorify God in this way. We will begin having a "Star of the Week" every week, to recognize and learn more about each of our classmates. Every week, one "star" student will be our leader and class helper, share information about themselves with the class, and is welcome to bring any show-and-tell items on M-W-F of that week. I will text you and let you know when it will be your child's turn.

Christ Light: Our stories this week are "The Twelve Spies" and "Korah's Rebellion".

Reading: Most of the children have finished reading their biography and wrote a report on the person they will be impersonating, for the History Fair in January. They will read their reports to the class and we will ask them questions about their person, to help prepare them for that night.

We will begin a reading new novel this week called "The Hundred Dresses" by Eleanor Estes.

Math: 3rd grade will learn about rectangles and rectangular width patterns, length and width, and multiplication as repeated addition; 4th grade will add and subtract numbers with more than three digits, learn one-digit division with a remainder, the calendar, prime and composite numbers.

English: Both grades will learn about using "a or an" in sentences, review helping verbs, learn about plural and singular words, and review classifying sentences. Spelling: 3rd grade words have complex consonants: soft g or soft c; 4th grade words have more letters than sounds.

Science: We continue to learn about "The Circle of Life" and learn lessons about why some plants give us flowers and fruit.
