**Notes from Mrs. Biedenbender:** Thank you for the great contributions of pop can tops last week! It was amazing to see how much was collected by not only our class, but all the others as well! Thank you also for encouraging your child to get off to a great start of our school's reading challenge by completing their November reading calendar!

Your child should have brought home their Christmas gift exchange letter with the person's name they chose. The gift limit is \$5 and you may send it along anytime before our Christmas party on the 22nd.

Christ Light: Our stories this week are "God's Rules for Worship" and "The Day of Atonement".

Reading: We will be reading a biography this week about a person we might be interested in being for our History Fair in January. The children will read the biography and write a report, to help them learn and remember facts about their important person from history.

Math: 3rd grade will learn about finding fractions and mixed numbers on a number line, comparing fractions, and probability; 4th grade will learn about relating multiplication and division, multiplying two-digit numbers, word problems about equal groups, and adding and subtracting decimal numbers.

English: Both grades will learn about coordinate conjunctions, compound sentences, classify sentences, and write some of our own to classify.

Spelling: 3rd grade words have two or three consonants together; 4th grade spelling words have the "ar" and "are" spellings.

Science: We are learning about "The Circle of Life"...last week we learned about the different lifespans of animals and the changes they go through in their lives. This week we will learn about mosquitoes and pollination.
