Happy New Year! We are happy to be back together again after the long break. We have a new MLC clinical student with us—Miss Mensching. She will teach a few classes every day, for the next two weeks.

Our school history fair is coming up January 17. Hopefully your child has a good idea of how they will dress up as their person, and has a start on their tri-fold board. They will bring home pictures they have printed off, and a question sheet to put on their board. They may bring their completed board to school anytime.
