Last week, we kept our head down and worked. The students have been doing a great job of staying on top of their work and getting it all done. We ended the week on a 10 day streak of having everything completed and turned in on time!

THIS WEEK IN THE UPPER GRADE CLASSROOM:

This is what we have coming up in some classes:

US History - The 7/8th graders have started our look at World War 1. We will be discussing our involvement in the war and the part we played overseas and what we did back in the US to support our troops!

Spelling - This week we have Lesson 20. There is a test on Friday this week.

MN History - For Minnesota History, we are going over the social issues that affected our state after World War 2. We will be looking at how different groups protested against issues that some were for or against. Once we are done with the chapter, I like to wrap up the book (Even though 5th graders have only had half of it) by having them interview various people asking them the question, "What does it mean to be a Minnesotan?"
