THIS WEEK IN THE UPPER GRADE CLASSROOM:

This is what we have coming up in some classes:

US History - We will be looking at the years between the wars including prohibition, the roaring 20s, and the beginning of the great depression.

Spelling - This week we have Lesson 22. There is a test on Friday this week.
