This is what we have coming up in some classes:

Spelling - This week we have Lesson 26. There will be a test on Friday.

Reading - This week we will be starting our new books. Check with your student on what they are reading today!

Coming up in science class is our look into the reproductive system. This will not be a sex education class, but instead how God has created our bodies to reproduce. 3rd and 4th Grade Weekly News

I hope you all had a blessed Easter with your families, and your children had a restful break!

Saturday, April 13, will be our school carnival, and we could still use some volunteers for it. Our 3rd and 4th grade class will be putting together a camping-theme gift basket for the silent auction. Look for more information to come home in a note, on Tuesday. We would like to have the items collected at school by Wednesday, April 10. Thank you for your help!

The following day—Sunday, April 14—the kids from our school will sing in church.

Christ Light: Our stories this week are “*Solomon is King*”, and “*The Idolatry of Solomon and Jeroboam*”.

Reading: We will finish reading our novel, then will return to reading in our basal reading book.

Math: 3rd grade will estimate to verify answers, round numbers to the nearest dollar, and multiply 3-digit numbers; 4th grade will estimate multiplication and division answers, solve word problems and problems about a fraction, and learn about average.

English: 3rd grade will review changing singular words into plural, and write a creative story. 4th grade will review beginning quotes and learn about ending quotes, and write a creative story.

Spelling: 3rd grade spelling words have the final e dropped in the base word, before adding the suffix -ing. 4th grade spelling words have the suffix -er.

Social Studies: We will learn about mountain ranges in the western U.S. and major ones in the world. We will also learn about the Pacific coast states.
