#### PREVIOUSLY IN THE UPPER GRADE CLASSROOM:

The students are continuing their rehearsals. This upcoming week they will not be using their books so please encourage them to work on their lines and have them ready. We are only 2 weeks away!

#### THIS WEEK IN THE UPPER GRADE CLASSROOM:

This is what we have coming up in some classes:

**Spelling** - This week we have Lesson 29. There will be a test on Thursday.

**Math** - Everybody will be taking a math test on Monday and/or Tuesday and Wednesday.

**5/6th Reading** - We are taking a couple of days to work on a Talk show. The students will act out a character and answer questions as if they were on a talk show.

**US History** - We have wrapped up World War 2 and will be shifting our focus to the years after the war and the Cold War.

**5/6th Catechism** - We will have a test on Wednesday on the means of grace, and the keys.

Coming up in science class this week, is our look into the reproductive system. This will not be a sex education class, but instead how God has created our bodies to reproduce.
