This is what we have coming up in some classes:

**Spelling** - This week we have Lesson 30. There is no test this week.

**Christ Light:** Our stories this week are: "*Hezekiah and the Assyrian Attack*" and "*Hezekiah's Sickness*".

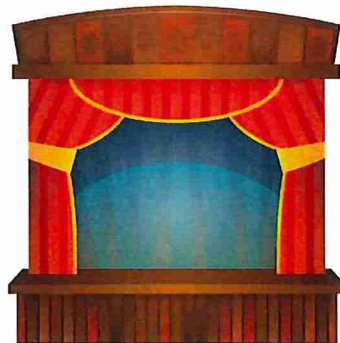
**Reading:** We are reading the novel in verse called "Gone Fishing" by Tamara Will Wissinger.

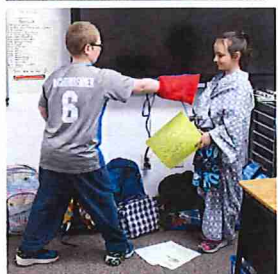
