This is what we have coming up in some classes:

Spelling - This week we have Lesson 27. There will be a test on Friday.

Math - Everybody will be taking a math test on Tuesday and Wednesday this week.

English - The 5/6th graders are taking a test on Monday this week.

World History - We have wrapped up our first chapter of Africa. They will have a test on Thursday on the geography, and climate of Africa.

This week, we will be welcoming our next student teacher, Mr. Miller. Mr. Miller is finishing up his student teacher experience here at Trinity for his last 6 weeks. We have been busy practicing our songs and lines for our school play. The children are catching on quickly, and are enjoying the fun pirate songs!

Christ Light: Our stories this week are: “Ahab and Elijah” and “Naboth’s Vineyard”.

Reading: We will read stories from our basal reader this week.

Math: 3rd grade learn how to multiply three-digit numbers, estimate weight or mass, effects of estimation, multiplying dollars and cents, and evaluating estimates; 4th grade will learn two-step problems about multiplication, average, mean, median, range and mode, geometric solids, and constructing prisms.

English: 3rd grade and 4th grade will review classifying sentences and write a creative story.

Spelling: 3rd grade words have double consonants with the suffix -ed or -ing; 4th grade words have the suffix -less or -ful.

Social Studies: We will finish learning about the western states, and some of our national parks.

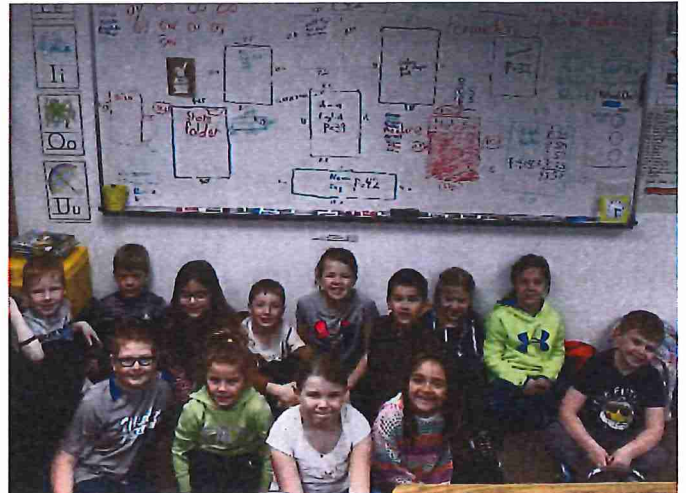

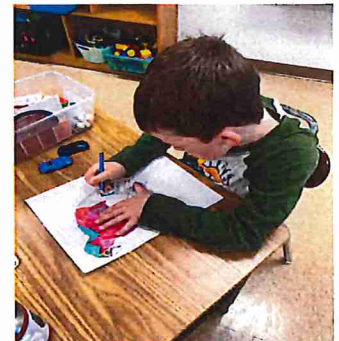

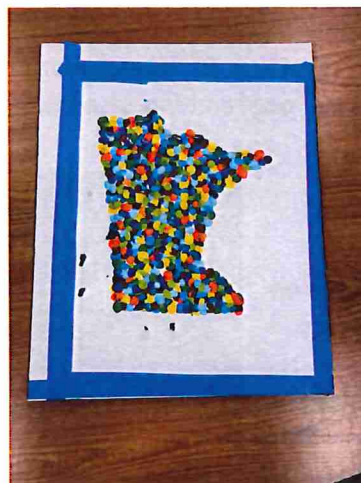
Bible verse: Mark 9:24 "I do believe; help me overcome my unbelief!"

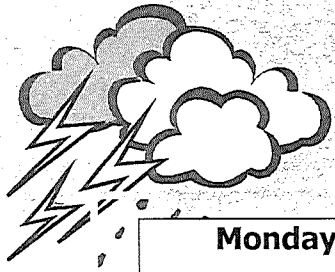
Music: We are learning songs for our play "Pirates."
