THIS IS HOW WE KNOW WE HAVE GOD'S LOVE

How can we be confident that God will follow through on all his promises to us? Simple: Jesus lives! If God faithfully fulfilled every ancient word he spoke about Jesus, then not a single word he speaks to us will be forgotten. If he raised the dead to indestructible life, then none of his promises are too big. If he has exalted Jesus in all glory and honor, then he will one day give us glory and honor, too. Our living Savior is the proof we need, and all our confidence rests in him.

"For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son..." Love is what God does, and Jesus perfectly embodied his love in his compassionate care, sacrificial death, and peace-restoring resurrection. Now, he has brought us into his family and given us his Spirit. God pours out the same supernatural power by which he raised Jesus from the dead on us, and he enables us to live a life of radically selfless love. He loves because he is God. We love because he first loved us.

THE MISSION OF TRINITY

The members of Trinity are joined together in Jesus' love to **worship** our Lord, **grow** in his Word, and **share** it with others.

WE WILL CELEBRATE THE LORD'S SUPPER IN TODAY'S SERVICE.

St. Paul writes that everyone who receives the Lord's Supper must "recognize the body of Christ," and therefore "ought to examine themselves" (1 Cor. 11:27-29) before eating and drinking. He also writes that it is God's desire that as his people commune, they do so as "one body" (1 Cor. 10:17), "perfectly united in mind and thought" (1 Cor. 1:10). For this reason, Trinity follows the biblical and historic practice of closed (or member) communion. We welcome members of WELS or ELS congregations to commune with us. If you are not a member of a church in fellowship with Trinity, please refrain from communing today. We want nothing more than to receive the Lord's Supper with you, but we want to do so in the unity of faith that Jesus wants for his people (cf. John 17:20-23). We hope that can happen soon! Please speak to our pastor after the service, and he would be happy to further explain our practice and help you work toward full unity with us.



In the name of the Father and of the + Son and of the Holy Spirit. **Amen.**




I tell you the truth, no one can enter the kingdom of God unless he is born of water and the Spirit.

Flesh gives birth to flesh, but the Spirit gives birth to spirit. (John 3:5,6)


Surely we were sinful at birth, sinful from the time our mothers conceived us. (*Psalm 51:5*)



³⁶In Joppa there was a disciple named Tabitha (in Greek her name is Dorcas); she was always doing good and helping the poor. ³⁷About that time she became sick and died, and her body was washed and placed in an upstairs room. ³⁸Lydda was near Joppa; so when the disciples heard that Peter was in Lydda, they sent two men to him and urged him, "Please come at once!"

³⁹Peter went with them, and when he arrived he was taken upstairs to the room. All the widows stood around him, crying and showing him the robes and other clothing that Dorcas had made while she was still with them. ⁴⁰Peter sent them all out of the room; then he got down on his knees and prayed. Turning toward the dead woman, he said, "Tabitha, get up." She opened her eyes, and seeing Peter she sat up. ⁴¹He took her by the hand and helped her to her feet. Then he called for the believers, especially the widows, and presented her to them alive. ⁴²This became known all over Joppa, and many people believed in the Lord.


