PREVIOUSLY IN THE UPPER GRADE CLASSROOM:

Some students are getting into their groove well and some needed a few harsher reminders this past week. We will get there and the new expectations will be second nature. Miss Butler led us in Science and Reading and is looking forward to continuing those subjects as well as adding in Intermediate 5 Math soon as well.

THIS WEEK IN THE UPPER GRADE CLASSROOM:

This Week, Dr. Tim Plath will be stopping by to ask students what their plans for high school are. Do not worry, he is not holding them to their answers. This brief little survey allows him to get into the schools, have a couple of students talk about MVL briefly and get an idea of MVL's future enrollment.

Here are some highlights for specific subjects this week:

Spelling - We will be doing unit 3 in Spelling. This subject will be mainly up to the students on when to get it done. Each unit needs to be completed by the end of the school week. Each unit has 4 pages so if they do one page a night on a normal school week, they will be done by Friday morning and ready for our test. This week, we will have our test on Friday.

Math - This week we will have our B test on Monday.

Science - This week, Miss Butler will be leading us in Science. She will continue to do so for most of her time here. She will be leading the students about maps, and rocks.

5/6th Catechism - This week in Catechism, we will be memorizing the books of the bible in order. This will help them find passages faster and help our classes move along. Repetition is the mother of all learning so keep having your student recite or read them each night! There are also some catchy songs you can find online as well!

English - The 5/6th graders are reviewing the fundamentals of sentences and the parts they need to be complete. The 7/8th graders are working on their writing to get ready for the different essays this year.

Finally, I will be sending a list of missing books from the book mobile this week. If you cannot find the books, let me know and I will relay the information to the librarian. She will let me know what to do after. Students with books still out cannot check out new ones until they do. That about sums it up for this week. If you have any questions, make sure to reach out!

Reading: We will continue reading "A Dog Called Kitty".



PRESCHOOL NEWS......SEPTEMBER 9-13, 2024

What We Are Learning:

Small Group: Our KDI for this week is focusing on art. We will be discovering how to create art with paint brushes, string, on foil, using watercolors, and making paper sculptures.
