Notes from Mrs. Biedenbender:

This Friday, the students of grades 1-4 will take a field trip to visit the Nicollet Wastewater Stabilization ponds. This will fit in with our new science unit on earth and it's natural resources, and our communities unit in Social Studies.

This Sunday, October 27, the school children will sing for church. Please have your child meet in the Fireside Room by 8:45 and wear their school t-shirt. You are welcome to stay for the chili cook-off afterwards!

Christ Light: Our new stories for this week are "Jesus and the People of Nazareth" and "Jesus Heals a Sick Woman".
