Our first quarter ends this week and you have probably noticed the email about parent-teacher conference sign ups for the following week. If you haven't been able to find a day or time that works for you, please let me know–I would be happy to work with you to find another time to meet!

Please note that we don't have school on Friday, November 1. Reading calendars will go home over the long weekend, so the children can begin their reading challenge (reading 300 minutes at home in November). As soon as they have met this goal, they should bring it back to school to be awarded a certificate for a free mini pizza from Nicollet Mart.

What we are learning this week:
