THIS WEEK IN THE UPPER GRADE CLASSROOM:

Spelling - This week we will be working on Unit 10 with a test on Thursday.

English - We are back into our English book this week after taking a little time off to focus on our Forensics pieces. The 5th-6th graders will be going through the writing process for the first time this year, and the 7th graders will be learning to write a persuasive essay.

Reading - We just started reading My Side of the Mountain as we focus on the theme of survival and independence. They struggled coming up with reasons to run away from home so nice job parents to make it difficult for them!

US History - We are wrapping up colonial life in America and will soon be learning about the Revolutionary War.

I mentioned the following in an email last week, but I wanted to address it again here:
