THIS WEEK IN THE UPPER GRADE CLASSROOM:

Spelling - This week we will be working on Unit 12 with no test this week. I will try to do make up tests on Friday for those that have missed one.

Math - We will be having a test on Thursday and Friday this week.

US History - The students will be working on their Battle Reports from the Revolutionary War. Miss Reedy will be leading her final lesson on Tuesday with them.

7/8th Reading - We have wrapped up our book, *Johnny Tremaine*, and will be beginning our next book this week. Check with your student what our next book is!

I want to give everybody a heads up about the Christmas Service recitation and narration parts. I went through the parts with them last week and told them to get started and have the first few memorized. We do not spend a ton of time in class going over them since they are able to read and practice. It is extremely important that they work on this at home. To adjust for the memorization, I do not do Religion memory work and try to limit the length of Catechism Memory work as well. I have not assigned the Narration parts yet as I wait to see how many Sunday School students will join in our grades. Those **DO NOT NEED TO BE MEMORIZED**. They should be practiced so they are comfortable, but not memorized.

Look for Science Fair information going home this week. We will be discussing the Scientific process and what needs to be present on their boards. I may have check points that students need to show progress, so this does not turn into a sprint the week before the Academic Fair.

I hope you all had a blessed Thanksgiving with your families!
Now that it is December, new reading calendars will come home. The children got off to a great start getting their November pizza certificates so quickly! We will also begin learning parts of our Christmas program now for our memory work. The children chose names for our Christmas gift exchange, and a (green) note was sent home with the information about who they picked. Let me know if you have any questions!

What we are learning this week:

Christ Light: Last week we learned about the important lessons Jesus taught on his sermon on the mount.. Our stories this week are "Jesus Heals a Captain's Servant" and "The Canaanite Woman".

Reading: We are enjoying our novel "The Family Under the Bridge", about a homeless man in Paris, whose life changes when he meets and befriends a struggling, poor family.

Math: 3rd grade will learn about fractions that equal one, recognizing equivalent fractions, finding fractions with mixed numbers on a number line, and comparable fractions; 4th grade will learn how multiplication and division are related, multiplying two-digit numbers, word problems about groups, and adding and subtracting decimal numbers.

English: The children did a great job writing their expository essays last week and have been enjoying reading them to the class. We will begin learning about helping verbs, coordinate conjunctions, natural and inverted word order. Science: We will finish learning about our earth's features and natural hazards. Social Studies: Last week we began a new unit about our communities' history. This week will learn how people and their inventions bring changes to their community over time.
