This last week, we said goodbye to Miss Reedy as she finished her experiences this semester. I also gave the students information and checkpoints for their Science Fair Projects that will be due in January for the Academic Fair. Please help remind them to be working on it over the next couple of weeks, especially if their experiment needs time to show results.

THIS WEEK IN THE UPPER GRADE CLASSROOM:

Spelling - This week we will be working on Unit 13 with a test on Friday.

US History - The students will be working on their Battle Reports from the Revolutionary War. Miss Reedy will be leading her final lesson on Tuesday with them.

7/8th English- We will have a test on their past couple of lessons this week on Wednesday.

Science - We will be wrapping up our look at earthquakes and the Earth's interior movements. We may also spend a little time going over their Academic Fair projects to make sure adequate progress is made and there are no misunderstandings about the process.

MN History - We will be having a test on Chapter 6 this week on Wednesday or Thursday. We have wrapped up the treaties with the Dakota and Obijwe Indians and how the United State's representatives and fur traders were not as honest as they could have been.

I want to give everybody a heads-up about the Christmas Service recitation and narration parts. I went through the parts with them last week and told them to get started and have the first few memorized. We do not spend a ton of time in class going over them, since they are able to read and practice. It is extremely important that they work on this at home. To adjust for the memorization, I do not do Religion memory work and try to limit the length of Catechism Memory work as well. I will be assigning the Narration parts this week. Those **DO NOT NEED TO BE MEMORIZED**. They should be practiced so they are comfortable, but not memorized.
