We are looking forward to our Science Fair this Wednesday, at 6pm. We are excited to see all the projects!

We have begun having a "star of the week", when one of our classmates gets to be the "star" by sharing favorites things about him or herself, is the leader and class helper for the week, and may bring things to show the class. Owen was our star last week, and Laven is our new star this week.
