This is what we have going on this week:

Reading 5/6 - With our book, *Roll of Thunder Hear My Cry*, there is language that is time-period specific. We have been working hard on the song we will be singing for church, Sunday, February 9. It's one of our favorite hymns to sing! Emmeryn is our star of the week this week!

Christ Light: Our stories this week are "The Parable of the Pharisee and the Tax Collector" and "The Parable of a Father's Love".

Reading: We continue to read "Little House in the Big Woods" and kdo some further research to learn even more about pioneer life.

Math: 3rd grade will learn about polygons, congruent shapes, triangles, more multiplication facts, and symmetry; 4th grade will learn similar and congruent figures, multiples of 10, division with and 2-digit answer, millimeters, and word problems about fractions.
