It is hard to believe that we are 3/4ths of the way through the school year. We were getting close to wrapping up books and chapters, so this week will be a study week with quizzes and tests. On the plus side, that would lead to little or no work over Spring Break!

THIS WEEK IN THE UPPER GRADE CLASSROOM:

This is what we have going on this week:

Spelling - This week we are going through Lesson 23 with a test on Friday.

US History - They will have a test on Tuesday about the Jackson Era on Wednesday.

World History - They will have a test on the history of major Latin American civilizations and settlements.

Reading - The 7th graders started a new book that is written in more of a poetry style than a typical chapter book. We will be using this opportunity to talk more about poetry. The 5/6th graders will be introduced to a new book this week. We will see if we get to start it before Spring Break.

Math - We will have a test on Tuesday and Wednesday this week on lessons 66-70.

Science - We will have a test on Friday on Erosion from chapter 8.
