THIS WEEK IN THE UPPER GRADE CLASSROOM:

This is what we have going on this week:

Spelling - This week we are going through Lesson 25 with a test on Friday.

US History - We will be speeding through the next couple of chapters to fill in details but help get us ready to dive into the Civil War later this year.

World History - I will be handing out rubrics and expectations for a country presentation they will be working on coming up. Each student will select a country from Latin America and do some simple research on that country. They will take notes and create a presentation for the class. For extra credit, they are able to bring in a signature dish from their country and share with the class.
