We Know Jesus Is Trustworthy

As we observe Easter, it is good for us to review the details: who, when, where. After all, Jesus' resurrection is a historical event – the historical event on which everything else hinges. But we risk missing the point if we simply recall the historic details of Easter. We must also see its significance: Jesus won! And that means something for us, today and every day. **Because He Lives**, not only is our eternity secure, but we have everything we need to live our present lives.

There's a difference between talking the talk and walking the walk. In his Word, Jesus promises many wonderful things: that he cares for you, that he would do anything for you, that he's leading you to the green pastures of paradise. How do you know you can trust what he says? Look at what he did. He gave his life to save you from your sin and took it back up again to prove that nothing can separate you from God. Now nothing can keep him from keeping his Word to you. This is what makes us sure that *Jesus is Trustworthy*: The Good Shepherd lay down his life for his sheep.

²⁶"Fellow children of Abraham and you God-fearing Gentiles, it is to us that this message of salvation has been sent. ²⁷The people of Jerusalem and their rulers did not recognize Jesus, yet in condemning him they fulfilled the words of the prophets that are read every Sabbath. ²⁸Though they found no proper ground for a death sentence, they asked Pilate to have him executed. ²⁹When they had carried out all that was written about him, they took him down from the cross and laid him in a tomb. ³⁰But God raised him from the dead, ³¹and for many days he was seen by those who had traveled with him from Galilee to Jerusalem. They are now his witnesses to our people.


